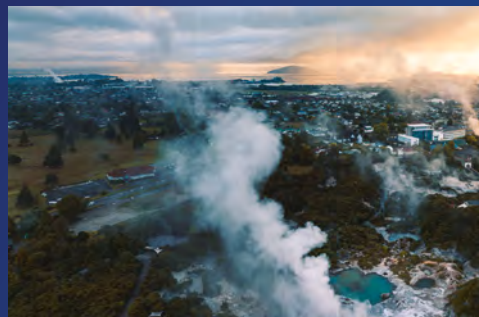

Mountain Bike Rotorua is your gateway to Whakarewarewa Forest, the stunning jewel in the crown of the adventure destination that is Rotorua.

The friendly team at Mountain Bike Rotorua have everything you need to get out and ride. You'll find their main base of operations at the Waipa mountain bike carpark on the southern end of the city. A full-service bike workshop, retail options and bike hire facilities are available here. The company also operates a bike rental shop at Te Pūtaka o Tawa carpark on Tarawera Road. Mountain Bike Rotorua also operates on-demand drop-off service for Skyline Rotorua Mountain Bike Park, New Zealand's first all-season, gondola-assisted network of mountain biking trails. The park is the home of the internationally renowned mountain bike festival, Crankworx Rotorua.

WHAKAREWAREWA, REDWOOD FOREST

Along with her natural beauty, the true strength of our forest is that it caters to all levels of riders. It doesn't matter if you've never been mountain biking before or you live, eat, breathe and dream about your next MTB fix, Whakarewarewa Forest has trails for you. With more than 200kms of trails for you to choose and explore, you can opt to hire our bikes for two hours, half day, full day, or go on multi-day adventures.

RETAIL SHOP

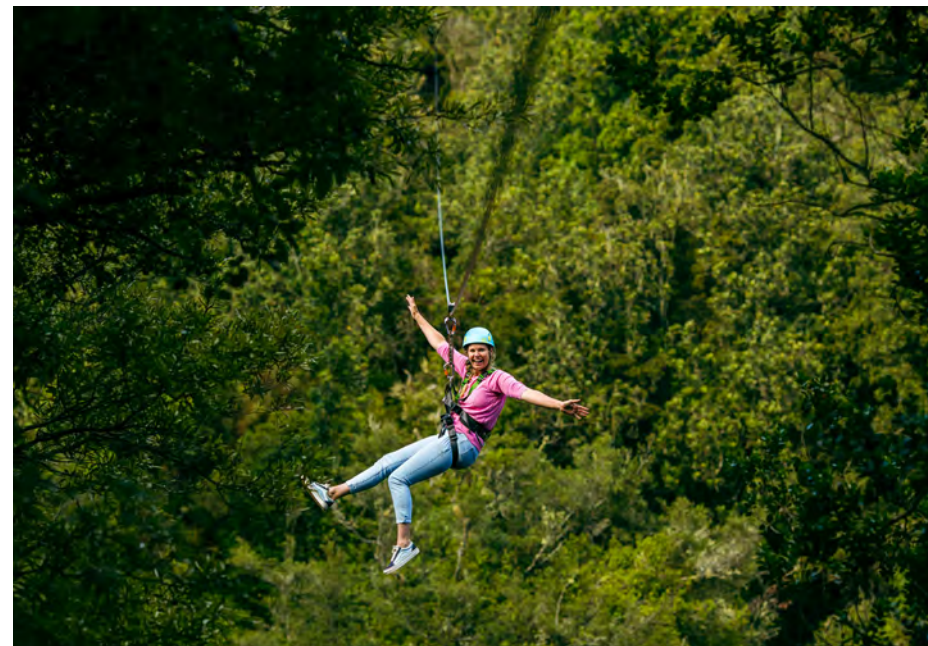

Wai-o-tapu Thermal Wonderland is a spectacular showcase of New Zealand's most colourful and diverse geothermal elements, sculpted by thousands of years of geothermal activity. Visitors walk through a uniquely different natural landscape where the key to what they see lies below the surface. This is one of the most extensive geothermal systems in New Zealand, extending over 1800 hectares.

A highlight of any visit to Wai-o-tapu Thermal Wonderland is the opportunity to see the Lady Knox Geyser. Geyser eruptions occur daily, sending jets of water and steam up to 10 -20 metres.

Visitors can choose to walk all or some of the three well-formed walking tracks, each of which has been created to show off a different facet of the unique environment.

Ticket purchase includes all day park admission with access to all walking tracks and entry to the Lady Knox Geyser.

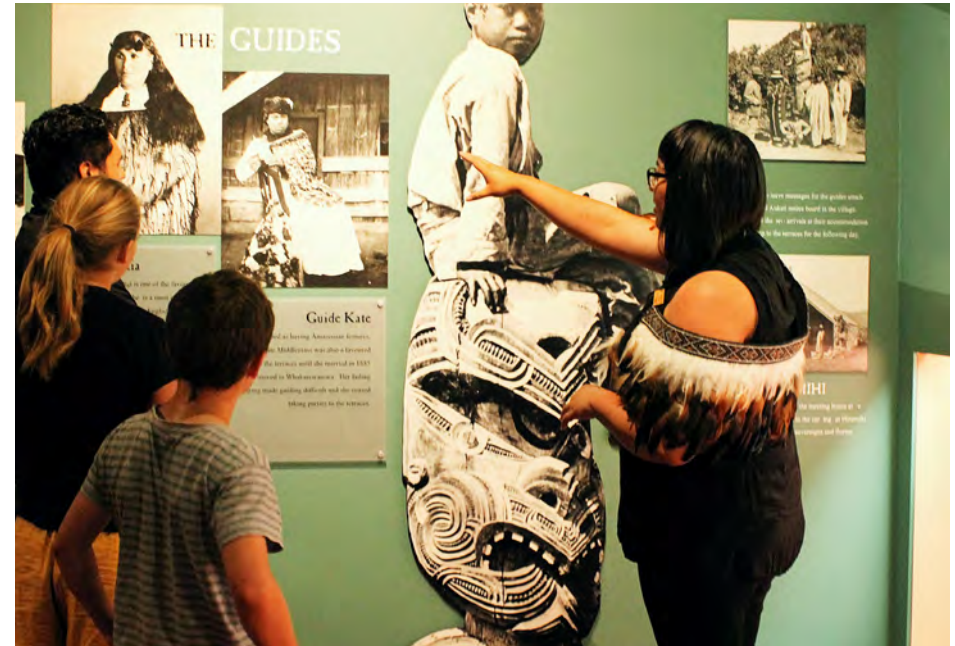

Pā (villages) sit at the epicentre of our communities - once places of physical refuge in times of war, they remain sanctuaries for our mind and spirit.

Pā are where we meet to discuss critical issues, where we celebrate and strengthen our own understanding of who we are.

Te Pā Tū presents seasonal culture and kai (cuisine) events – sharing Māori history, traditions, and future aspirations across three and a half hours of celebration and feasting. Our experiences align with the maramataka (Māori lunar calendar).

Tū Te Ihi spans the time of year when the Matariki cluster of stars sit high and bright in our winter skies. Tū Te Rā celebrates summer, the time when the sun expresses optimal energy, the days are longer, and light nourishes the natural world.

Each is a four-hour feast of knowledge and divine seasonal kai (cuisine) within our forest Pā (sanctuary), its tawa trees and crackling bonfires.

Kai horotai (morsels) welcome guests with seasonal favourites and kawakawa tea. Within the forest-formed amphitheatre attention shifts to stories relayed through haka, song, and drama, before manuhiri (guests) settle in for a four-course feast.

- Guests can pause at the Geyser Terrace to take in views of the magnificent Pōhutu Geyser. The trail concludes with a farewell beneath the glow of Mārama (the moon), passing through the traditional setting of Pīkirangi Village.
- The 1.5 km track takes approximately 60 minutes to explore at a leisurely pace. Some visual effects may be intense and could cause discomfort for guests with light sensitivity or motion sickness. Comfortable footwear and warm clothing are recommended. Due to unpaved paths, the experience is not suitable for wheelchairs or prams.

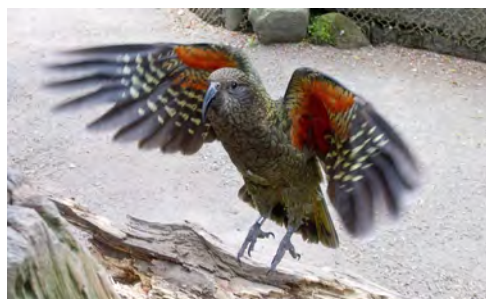

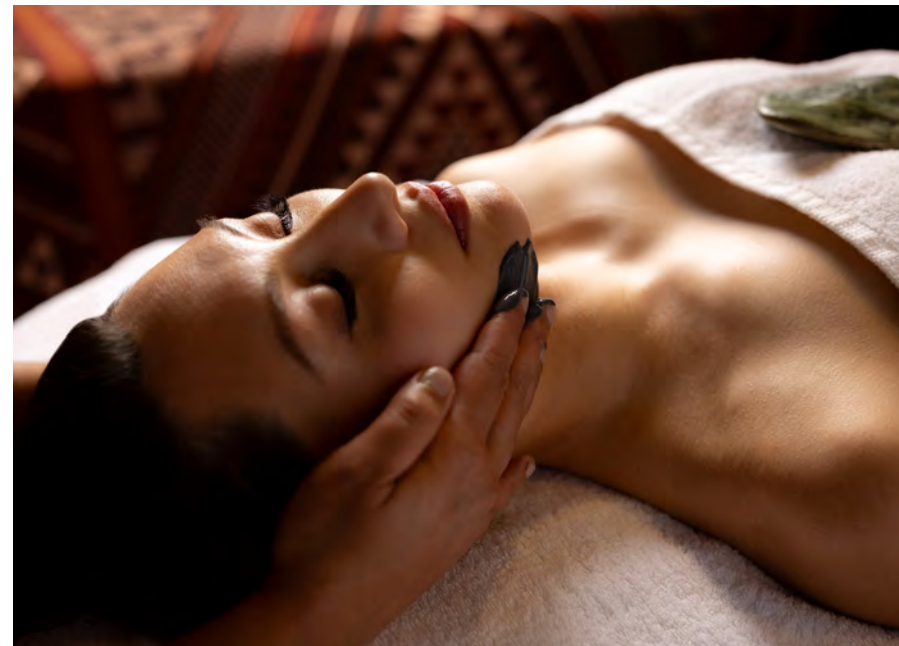

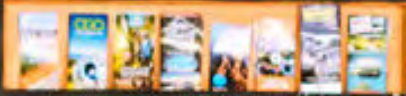
