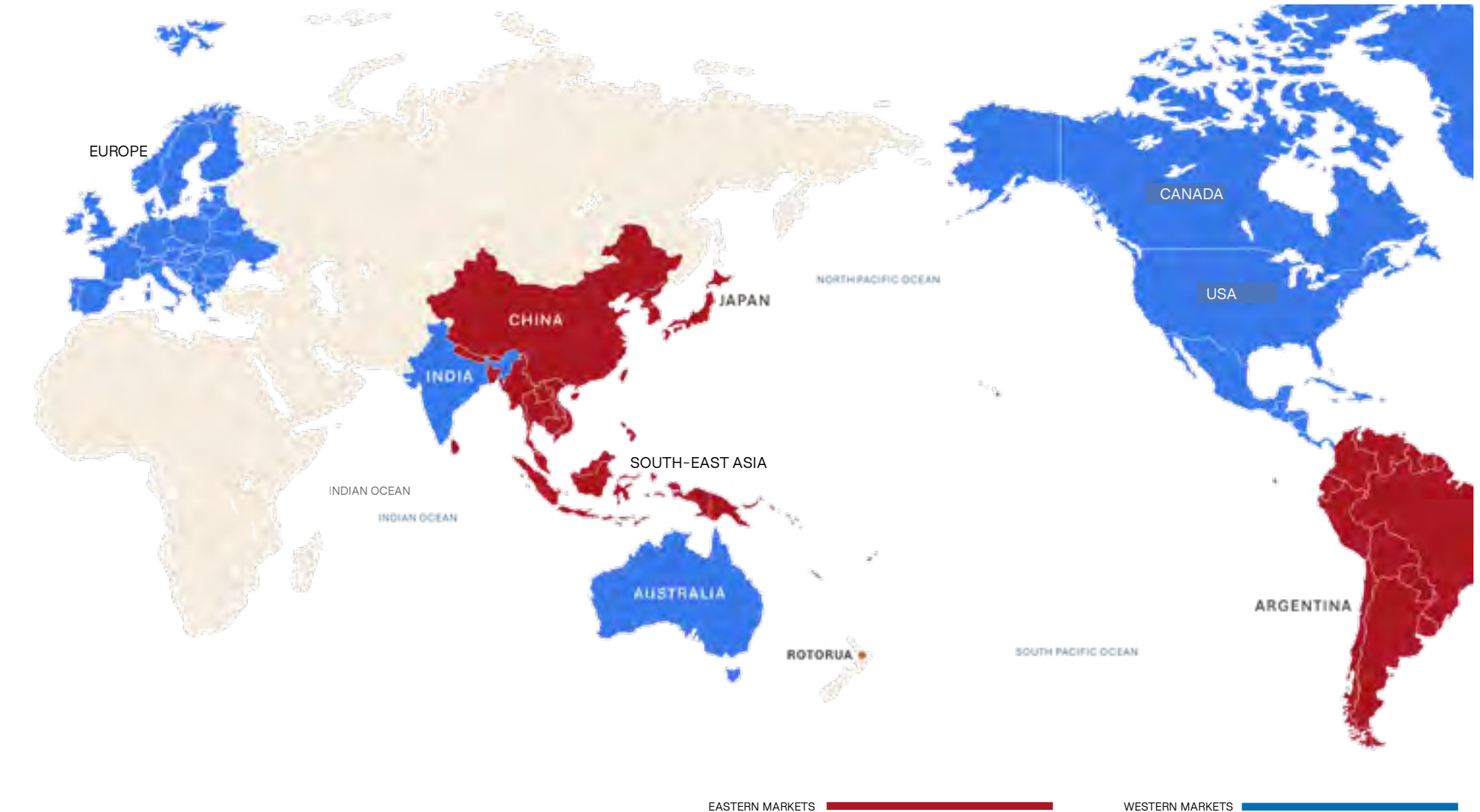

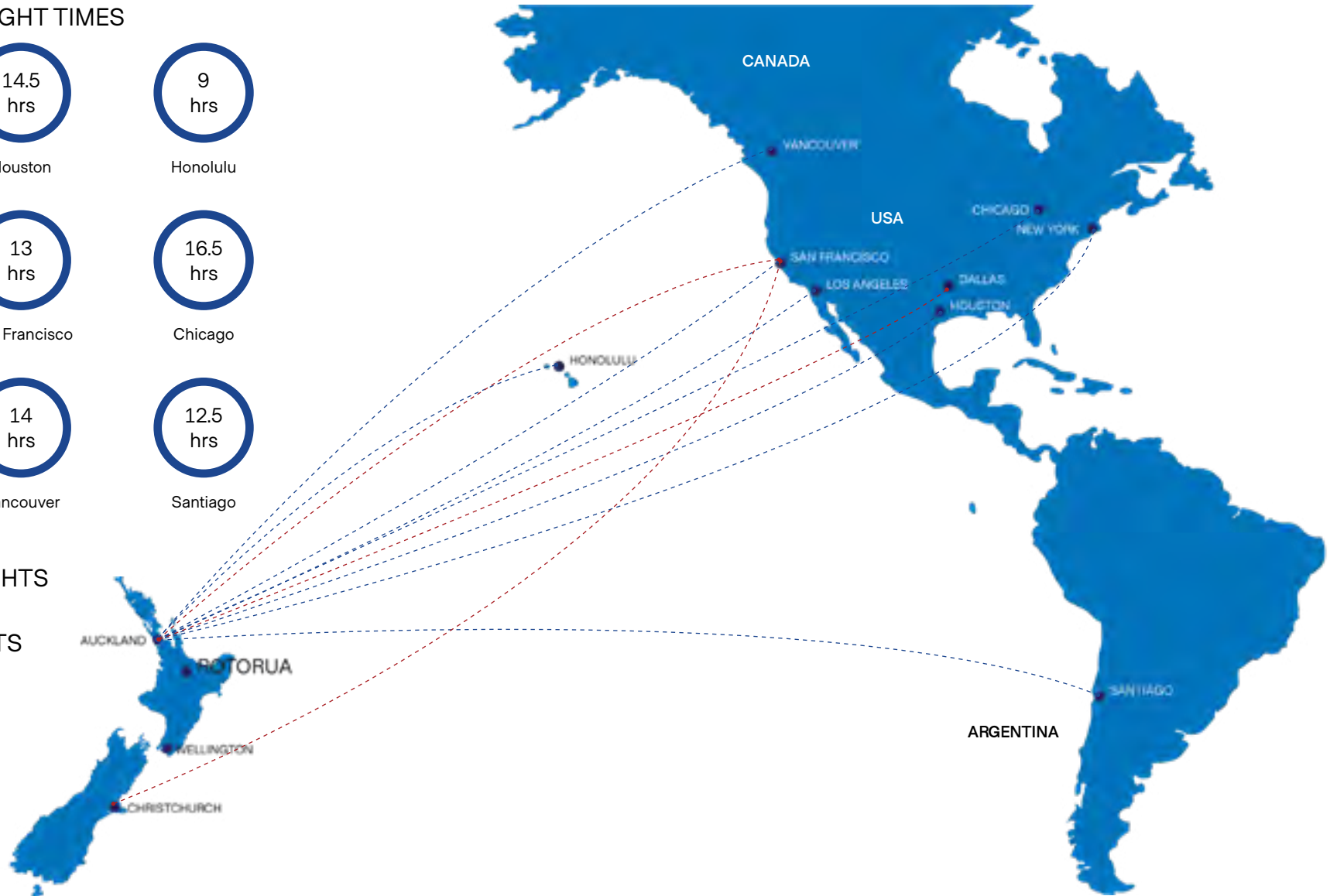

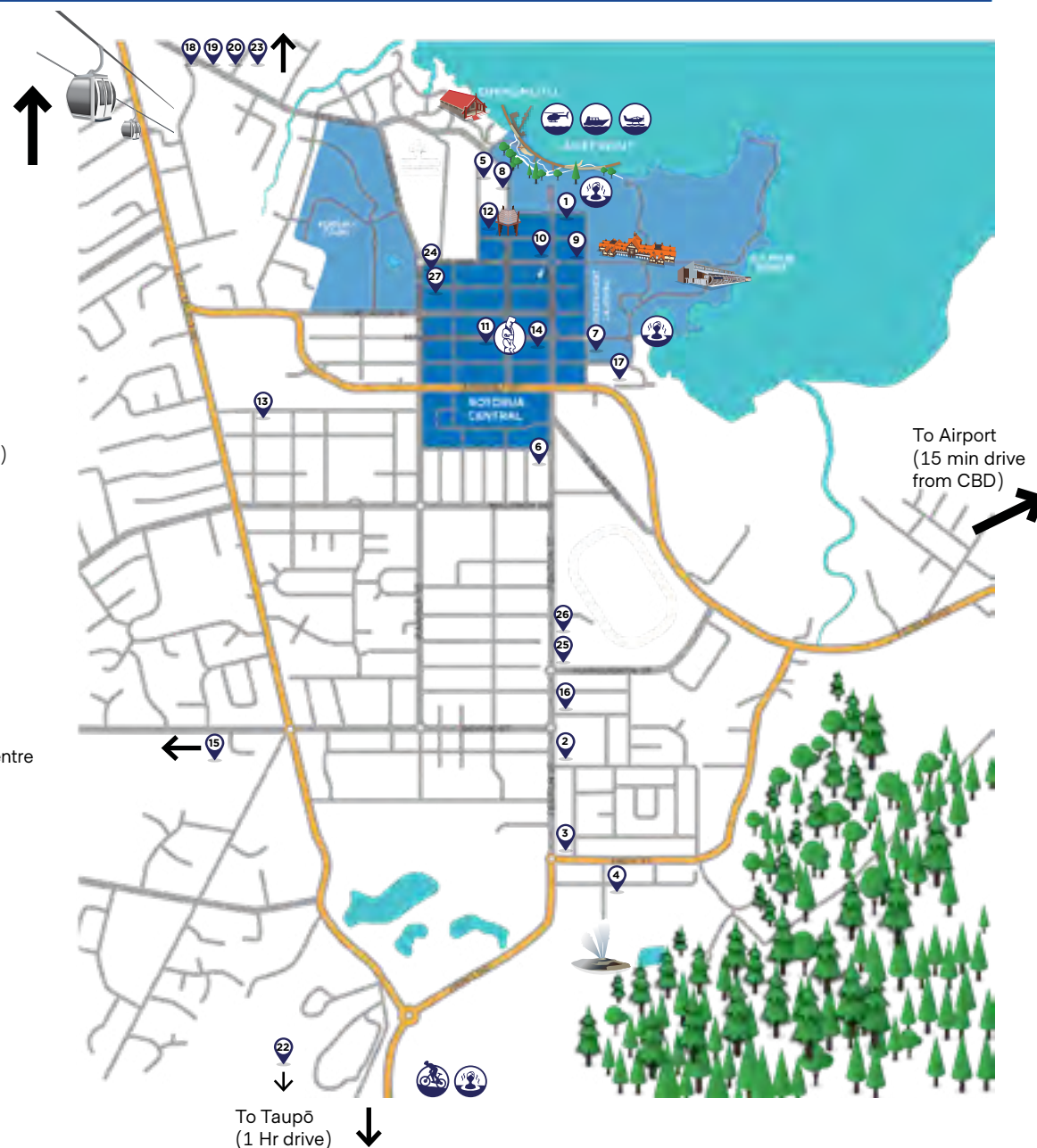

INTRODUCTION

Adventure Playground Rotorua is an outdoor adventure operator offering guided 4WD buggy tours, horse trekking, clay bird shooting, archery and target shooting experiences across 750 acres of native bush on the slopes of Mount Ngongotahā. Located just 10 minutes from Rotorua’s city centre, visitors make their own way to the venue. Experiences showcase spectacular views over Lake Rotorua while combining adventure with the region’s natural landscape and local Māori history. CLAY BIRD SHOOTING

This family friendly 4WD buggy experience takes guests across Mount Ngongotahā with experienced guides sharing local history, Māori culture and legends. The journey passes through native bush, silver ferns and wildlife, finishing at a high lookout with panoramic views over Lake Rotorua, Mokoia Island and the city.

A minimum of three hours is recommended. Visitors can jig or troll for the famous rainbow trout, before finishing with a dip in the thermal springs or having their catch cooked in one of nature’s natural sous vide hot springs. Fishing is available from 1 October to 30 June.

FLY FISH THE LAKES, RIVER & STREAMS OF THE REGION

Exciting rainbow and brown trout provide a challenge for anglers of all skill levels. Depending on the time of year, visitors can experience exciting dry fly, nymphing, and wet fly action.

SLEDGE THE KAITUNA – GRADE 3

This fully guided river experience offers native scenery, play holes and rapids navigated at water level. Participants control their own sled using foot flippers while guides provide support and encouragement. Suitable for all abilities, it is designed as an accessible and family friendly adventure.

MT TARAWERA VOLCANIC CRATER EXPERIENCE – HALF DAY

This guided walking experience explores Mount Tarawera, the site of the 1886 eruption that formed the Waimangu geothermal valley and destroyed the Pink and White Terraces. The journey highlights geological and cultural history, with panoramic 360 degree views and an optional descent into the volcanic crater.

MT TARAWERA VOLCANIC CRATER EXPERIENCE – FULL DAY

This extended guided experience builds on the half day crater walk, adding a hike around the Tarawera Dome above lakes Rotomahana and Tarawera before joining the summit route at Ruawahia peak. It offers an immersive exploration of the volcanic landscape, with an optional descent into the crater.

Katoa Jet offers thrilling jet boat experiences across the pristine waters of Lakes Rotorua and Rotoiti, combining high-speed adventure with commentary on the region’s history, culture and iconic landmarks. This experience delivers high-speed experiences on Lake Rotorua, with powerful engines reaching up to 85 km/h and skilled drivers performing 360° spins. Tours visit iconic landmarks while sharing the history, people, and events that have shaped the area into New Zealand’s cultural capital for visitors of all ages and interests. Duration 30 minutes.

LAKE ROTOITI HOT POOLS BY JET BOAT

Offering a high-speed journey across Lake Rotorua, through the Ohau Channel to Lake Rotoiti. The experience includes a visit to Manupirua Hot Springs for a one-hour soak. Accessible only by water, the hot pools also offer refreshments available for purchase during the stop. Duration 2.5 hours.

MOUNTAIN BIKE ROTORUA



INTRODUCTION

Mountain Bike Rotorua is a one-stop hub for exploring the world-renowned trails of Whakarewarewa Forest, offering premium bike hire, guided rides, shuttle services, skills coaching and bike servicing. Located at Waipa, in the heart of the forest trail network, with an additional rental outlet at Te Pūtaka o Tawa, the team also provides on-demand transfers to Skyline Rotorua Mountain Bike Park. Catering to riders of all ages and abilities, Mountain Bike Rotorua is ideal for beginners, experienced riders, families with older children, FIT travellers and various groups looking to experience one of New Zealand’s premier mountain biking destinations. Mountain Bike Rotorua includes a small retail shop with essential items such as tubes, pumps, helmets, gloves, tools, and bike maintenance products, along with a selection of branded clothing.

Wheelhouse Coffee Shop, located at Te Puia in the southern carpark, provides a convenient stop for riders and walkers. It serves coffee made with locally roasted Mourea Coffee beans, along with a small range of drinks.

MONSTER 4X4 THRILL RIDE

Off Road NZ offers guided 4X4 thrill rides through native forest, following historic logging tracks from the early 20th century. Experienced drivers lead the journey, showcasing a unique side of Aotearoa while navigating rugged terrain for an immersive off-road adventure experience.

RACELINE KARTING

This experience offers Raceline Karting on a 1.2km outdoor track, where participants take the driver's seat for a high-speed experience. The activity challenges concentration, skill, and confidence, providing an exhilarating racing environment designed for those seeking a competitive and fast-paced karting adventure.

CLAYBIRD SHOOTING

Off Road NZ offers a claybird shooting experience that tests accuracy and skill using real shotguns and live ammunition. Designed as a team-building activity, it encourages group bonding while participants learn a new skill in a challenging and engaging environment.

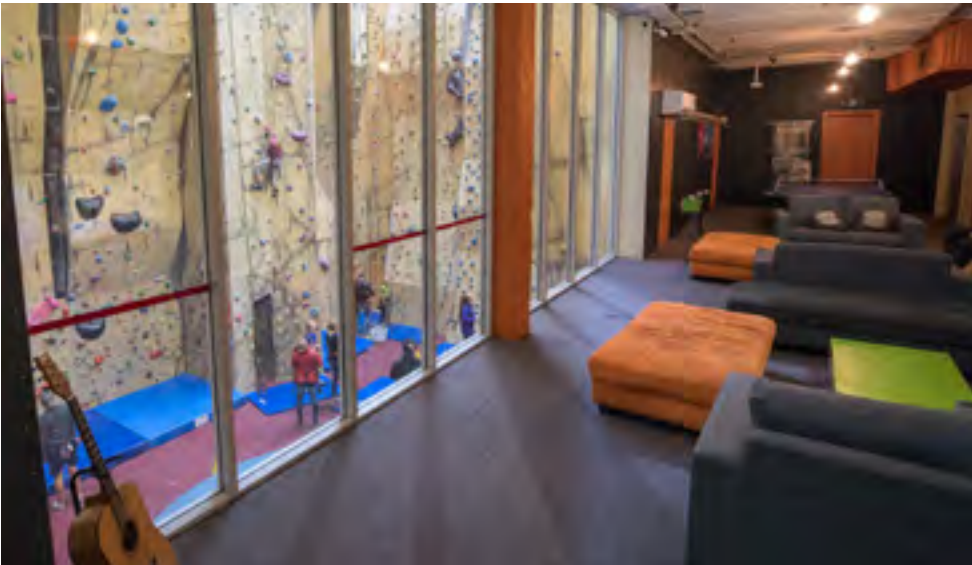

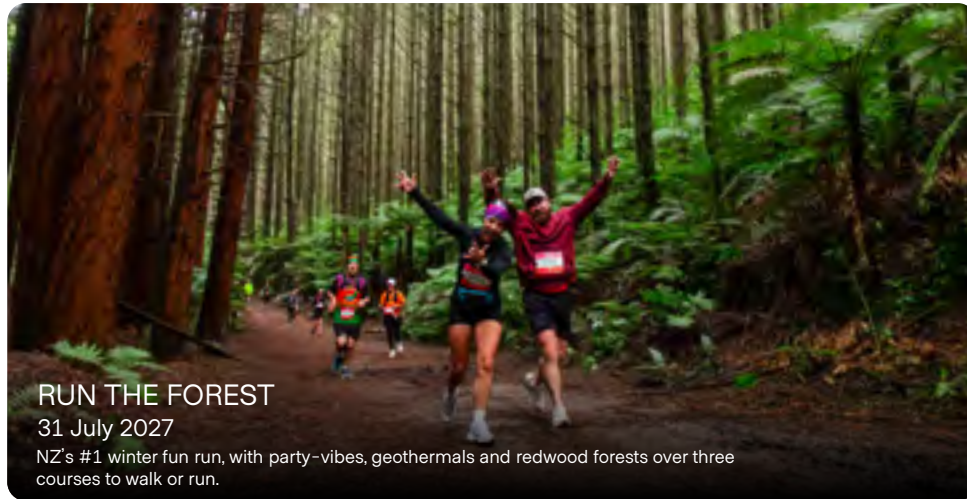

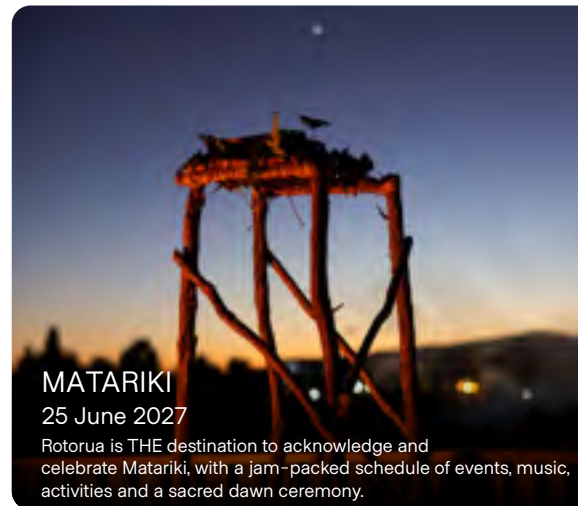
